Hamerton Zoo Park is, as of Feb 2016, a registered “Learning Destination” for the Children’s University. Children can collect credits in their CU Passport by visiting us.

If your child has a “Passport to Learning”, please bring it with you when you visit the zoo. There is lots for children to learn, just by visiting and seeing the animal collection. Bring the passport to the giftshop counter during your visit to be stamped. A zoo visit is worth 1 hour credit (even if you are here much longer than that)

If you want to earn extra credit, we have some downloadable quizzes, picture trail and other worksheets, which you can print and bring to the zoo to complete as you walk around. One worksheet is worth an extra half-hour of credit, two or more are worth 1 hour. Show your completed sheets to the shop staff to get your passport stamped!

During the summer holidays, there may be additional zoo-keeper talks which can earn even more credits!
